






SUMMARY DESCRIPTION

An obvious bank marks the boundary for much of the length. There is a similar bank along the roadside and the reason for the boundary position is not apparent. Some 400m north of Peters Gore the boundary leaves the line of the road to follow a ditch taking spring water and then take in a small area of grassland that looks like a common before returning to the roadside bank.

Trees of varying age and an intermittently intact hedge grows on the bank.
